



PROJET NAME: Sustainably Participatory Forest Protection and Conservation (SPFPC)



PROJET GOAL: Three community's targets have strong ability to protect and conservation biodiversity

1-End of 2019, Three ToT have capacity deliver training to 15 ToT at community level and awareness to 180 CF members (108 women) on REDD+ concept and involve conservation their communities.

Ouput1.1: Three core trainers from AFD, FAC and CF improved their skill and enabled to transfer knowledge on Concept of REDD+ and Use of REDD+ Extension Materials to CF member at sub-national level after receiving a ToT on the above subjects at national level. **Activities:.....**

Ouput1.2: 15 CFMC members (6 women) attended training on REDD+ concept increased knowledge on CBR+ concept and Use of REDD+ Extension Materials and transfer the knowledge to 180 CF members (108 women) **Activities:.....**

2-End of 2019, Three communities Forestry have 180 member increases income 60\$ per year through smart agriculture resilience with climate change.

Ouput3.5: Khmum Srakor Thlok Reussey, Trapeang Rong and Prey Tapres CFs trialed silviculture operation in two hectares each to better growth and quality of stands.

Ouput3.6: Three natural ponds located in the three CFs (each pond per CF with equal dimension of 40m x 20m x 3m) were rehabilitated for the sake of drinking water for wildlife, increase in fishery resource and ground water recharge. **Activities:**

Ouput3.7: Three-hectare plot of the ecotourism site in Trapeang Rong CF was plowed to plant sunflowers for entertainment. **Activities:**

Ouput3.8: Two potential sites in Trapeang Rong and Khmum Srakor Thlok Reussey CFs were identified, selected and developed as ecotourism sites under official recognition of the concerned commune chief. **Activities: ...**

Ouput3.9: Ten families who are members of these CFs attended training on technique of using and maintaining bio-gas stove to save fuel wood consumption. Each of them contributed in cash of US\$ 195.00 and received a bio-gas stove for cooking. **Activities: ...**

3-End of 2019, Three communities forestry have capacity to conservation and sustainable used forest areas 1891 has through increased forest cover 5 has, 7,000 trees planting, prepare community ecotourism, used biogas and agroforestry to improve ecosystem for reduced emission and climate resilience.

Ouput3.1: 25 CFMC members better understood CF management structure and were able to enabled to share ideas on basic rights of local communities to manage natural resource in sustainable manner as well as access to the relevant information. **Activities:**
